Pastor Job Description

Job Title: Pastor

Reports to: Church Council

Position: Full Time (may require supplemental income)

Purpose: The Pastor is responsible to the church for proclaiming the gospel of Jesus Christ, for using his skills in leadership, for engaging in pastoral care ministries and to meet the needs of persons in the church and in the community.

Responsibilities:

- Set as a guideline of personal behavior the standard required in 1 Timothy 3:1-7 and 1 Peter 5:1-4
- Provide leadership for the total church program.
- Lead and provide discipleship and training of the church body.
- Maintain a regular program of study to enable himself to plan and conduct meaningful worship services.
- Prepare for and conduct worship services, lead in the observance of the ordinances, and to lead the church in proclaim the gospel to the church and community.
- Visit members and prospects and lead the membership in visitation.
- Conduct premarital, vocational, family and bereavement counseling as needed.
- Perform wedding ceremonies and conduct funeral services.
- Work with the Council members and committee members in performing assigned responsibilities.
- Be available for and to lead in training as needed.
- Cooperate with and lead the church in cooperating with the Rocky Mountain Bible Mission.
- Serve as leader in seeking to win the unsaved and lead the church body in soul-winning training.
- Plan and promote periods of evangelistic emphasis for the unsaved and renewal for the Christians.
- Submit to an annual evaluation from the Council

Compensation:

- Starting salary: \$1,000.00 per month plus housing and utilities. (BCBC provides its 4-bedroom parsonage near the church and all utilities.)
- As member of RMBM, which is a requirement of employment, you will have the opportunity to raise outside missionary support to supplement income.
- Outside work as needed to supplement income is permitted.
